# Background

- ▶ Statute directs CalSTA to approve a 5-year program of projects covering 2018–19 through 2023–24
- ▶ Robust funding due to Senate Bill 1 and Assembly Bill 398 (Cap and Trade extension) – about \$2.6 billion over 5 years
- ▶ Statute authorizes recipients to apply to the CTC for a letter of no prejudice
- ▶ Statute authorizes CalSTA to execute a multi-year funding agreement of any duration, in cooperation with the CTC
