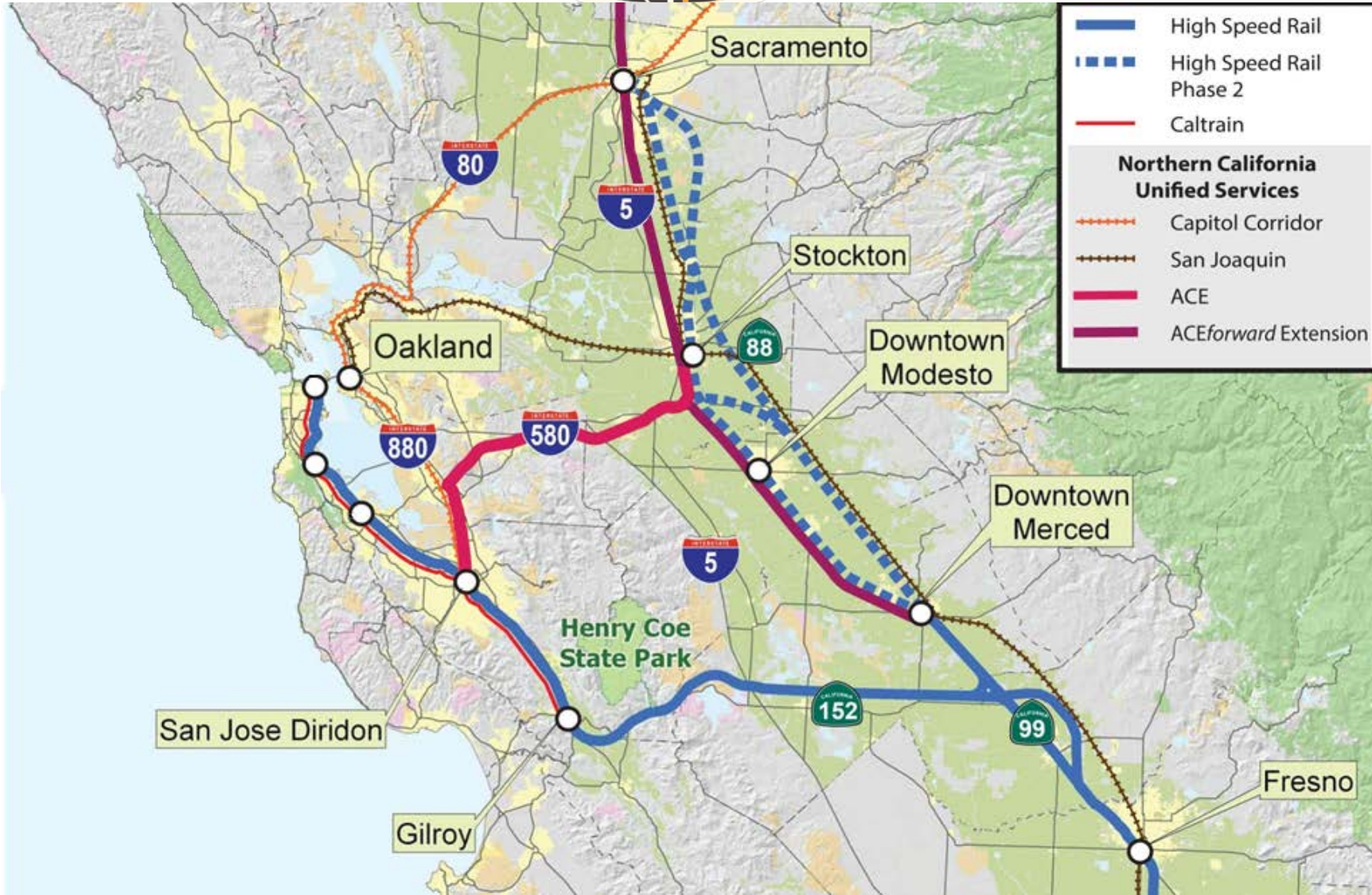

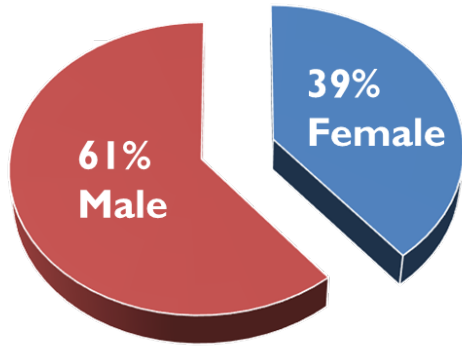

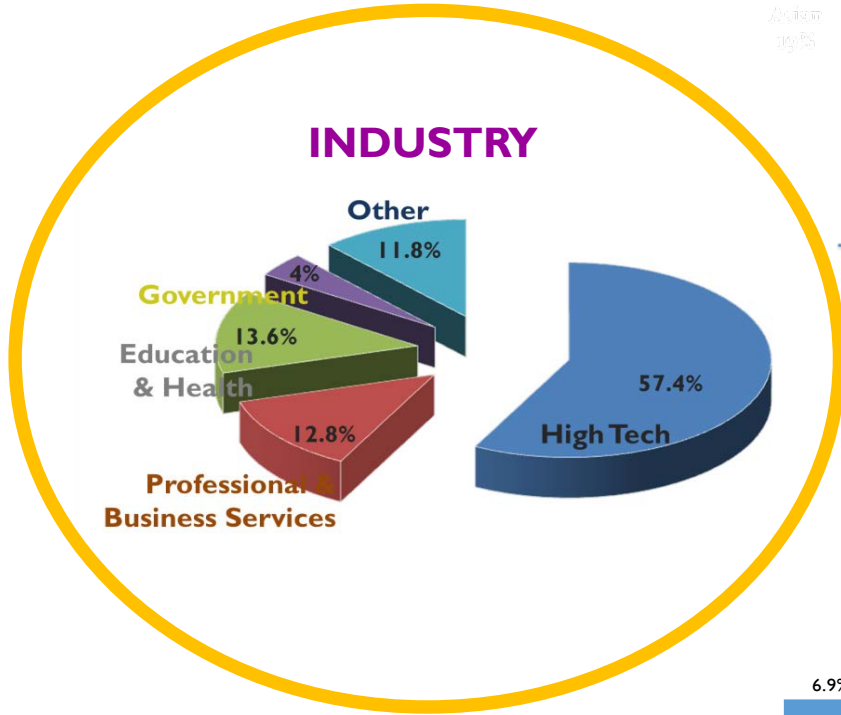
Annual Ridership Comparison of Most Similar Services

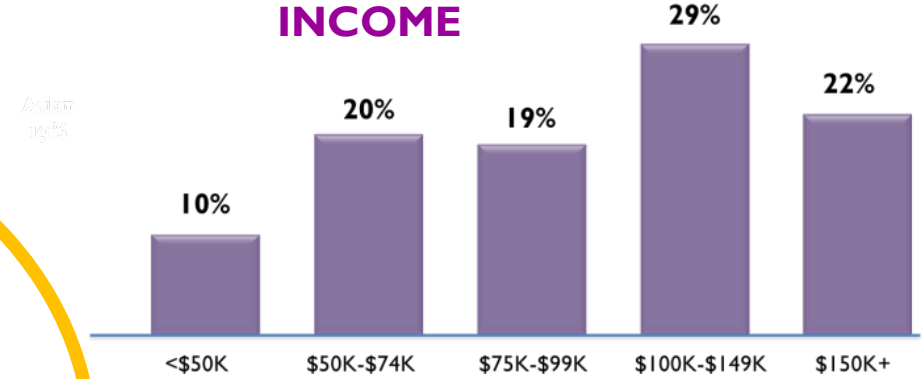

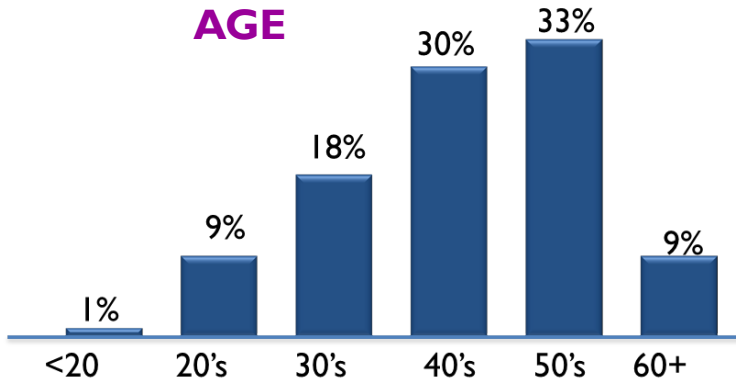
Who Rides?



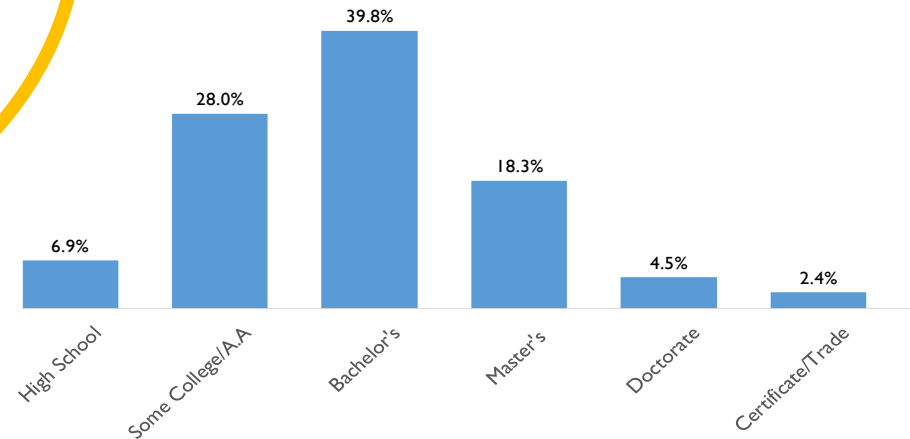
INCOME



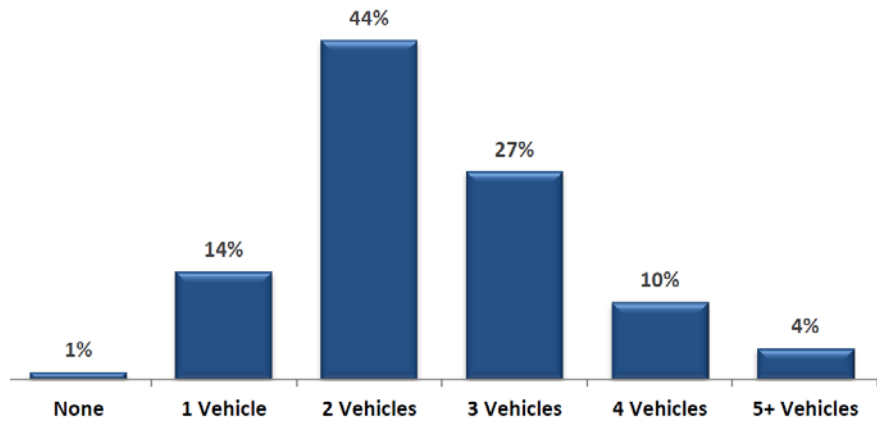

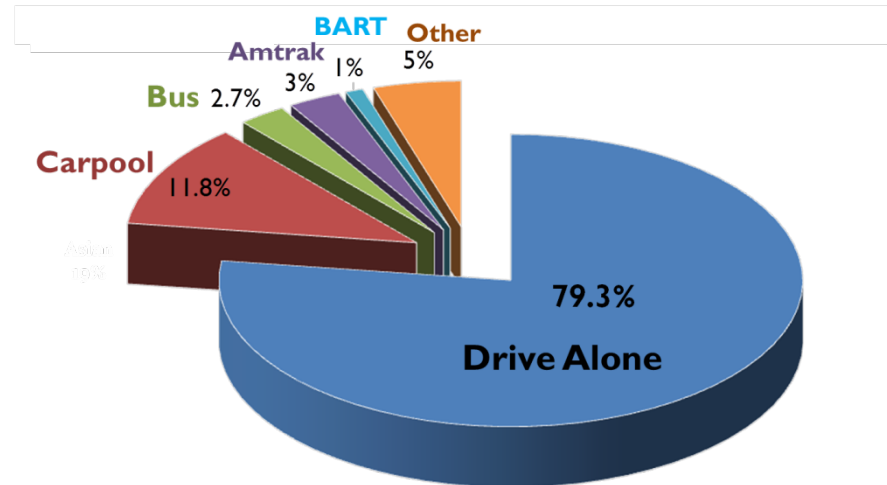

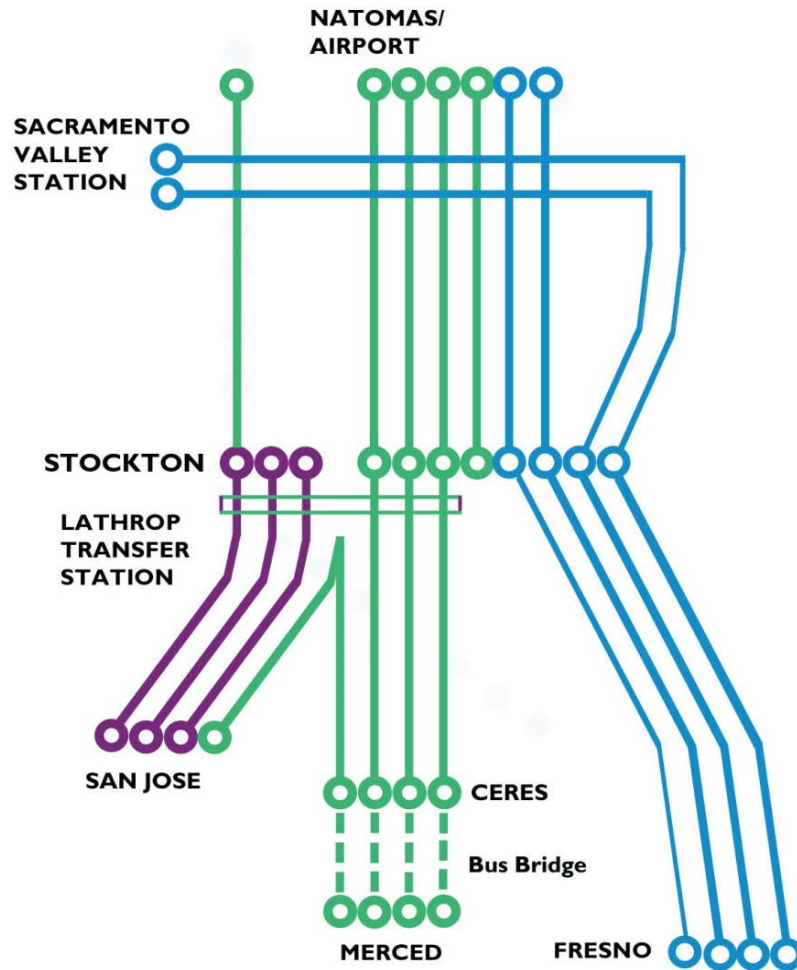

Valley Rail Services



The Focus:

- Final Env. Clearance for all 2020 and 2023 projects (80% Complete)
- Equipment procurement for additional ACE and San Joaquin trains
 - Locomotives lead time = 2 years (4 loco's under contract)
 - New intercity coaches = 3 years
 - New commuter coaches = 2 years (Pending Joint Procurement)
 - Rehabilitated equip. (if available) = 18 months to 2.5 years
- Finalize station and facility locations with Host RR's and local communities
- Bid documents for track, bridges, stations, layover facilities, existing platform extensions, modifications, etc)

The Focus:

- Coordinate existing and new shuttle services and 1st/last mile connections
- Work with CalSTA and Caltrans on early pilot program for integrated ticketing on connecting modes
- Work with CalSTA and SGC on a pilot TIRCP Technical Assistance (TA) Program to increase disadvantaged community benefits in TIRCP projects
