Notice – Active Transportation Program (ATP) Guidelines Workshops

The California Transportation Commission (Commission) adopts guidelines for the Active Transportation (ATP) to describe the policy, standards, criteria and procedures for the development, adoption and management of the ATP. The 2014 guidelines, adopted in March 2014, were developed in cooperation with Caltrans, regional transportation planning agencies, other government agencies, and active transportation stakeholder organizations with expertise in pedestrian and bicycle issues in accordance with Streets and Highways Code Section 2382.

To enhance transparency and accountability in administering the 2015 ATP, the Commission intends to update the ATP guidelines by working with interested stakeholders. Workshops will be held to focus on proposed guidelines revisions, although other program areas may be discussed as time permits. Commission staff has prepared a discussion draft of the guidelines for the 2015 ATP that primarily focuses on clarifications of existing policies and Commission and Department roles and responsibilities. Staff is also proposing to delete the match requirement and provide some flexibility to transfer funds between allocated components.

The workshops are open to interested stakeholders and will be held in December of 2014 and January of 2015. The first workshop was held on December 2, 2014. The second workshop is scheduled for:
