CTP Guidelines Workgroup Meeting
Caltrans Headquarters – 1120 N Street, Sacramento, CA

The California Transportation Plan (CTP) Guidelines Workgroup met in Sacramento on October 26th to discuss the September 21, 2016 Public Review Draft.

Garth Hopkins from California Transportation Commission (CTC) led the meeting and started with Introductions.

Mark Barry from Caltrans Office of State Planning (OSP) gave a presentation on the status of the Guidelines, timeline for the development of the Guidelines and the purpose of this meeting.

Garth Hopkins opened up the floor for comments and began by reviewing the Guidelines by each individual section. Below is a brief overview of the comments:

Introduction: Add information on CEQA to Table 1.

Section 1: Add Senate Bill 350 and Senate Bill 32. Add EO-B-16-12 ZEVs. Recommend enhancing the language in the Senate Bill 391 section.

Section 2: Ensure that the new 2030 target is included.

Section 3: Recommend using the language “integrated” instead of “consistent” in the RTP sections.

Section 4: Add MPO’s in the Agency Collaboration (SB 391) section.

Section 5: Add MPO’s in the Final Review section.

Next Steps: Staff will work on comments and make edits on the Guidelines and aim to post another draft in the middle to end of November. These Guidelines are on track to be presented at the December California Transportation Commission meeting with an aim for approval in early 2017.
