Subject: Adoption of the 2021 Federal Transit Administration Section 5310 Enhanced Mobility

of Seniors and Individuals with Disabilities Program – Small Urbanized and Rural

Areas Component

Recommendation:

Staff recommends that the California Transportation Commission (Commission) adopt the 2021 Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Section 5310 Enhanced Mobility of Seniors and Individuals with Disabilities Program (Section 5310 Program) – Small Urbanized and Rural Areas Component as proposed in Attachment B.

<u>lssue:</u>

The funding available for the 2021 Section 5310 Program is \$15,196,193. The 2021 Section 5310 Program proposes to program 103 projects as follows:

- 81 projects totaling \$8,801,116 for the Traditional Program; and
- 22 projects totaling \$6,395,077 for the Expanded Program.

The 2021 Section 5310 Program also includes a contingency projects list should funding become available due to savings or project deletion. The contingency lists include 22 Traditional projects, totaling \$1,419,906, and three Expanded projects, totaling \$622,914.

Background:

Government Code Section 14055 et seq., requires the Commission adopt the FTA Section 5310 Program – Small Urbanized and Rural Areas component. Prior to adoption, the Commission is required to establish an appeals process and hold at least one public hearing.

The Draft 2021 Section 5310 Program was presented to the Commission at the May 2022 Commission meeting. On June 1, 2022, the Commission and State Review Committee held the required appeals hearing, where one appeal was heard. The appeals hearing did not result in any changes to the draft 2021 program of projects.

- 1.1 **WHEREAS**, Federal law (Title 49 U.S.C. Section 5310) provides for capital, operating assistance and mobility management grants for the purpose of assisting private non-profit corporations and, under certain circumstances, public agencies in providing transportation services to meet the needs of seniors and persons with disabilities for whom public mass transportation services are otherwise unavailable, insufficient, or inappropriate, and
- 1.2 WHEREAS, State law, Assembly Bill 772 (Chapter 669, Statutes of 1996), placed the following three mandates on the California Transportation Commission (Commission) regarding the Program: a) The Commission shall direct the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) on how to allocate funds for the Program; b) The Commission shall establish an appeals process for the Program; c) The Commission shall hold at least one public hearing prior to approving its Program of Projects, and
- 1.3 **WHEREAS**, the Commission worked with the State Review Committee, a 15-member advisory committee made up of individuals from the Regional Transportation Agencies, state and local social service agencies, the California Association for Coordinated Transportation, Caltrans and Commission staff, to develop a process that provides for a statewide ranked list of Small Urban and Rural Area projects to be adopted by the Commission and funded by Caltrans, and
- 1.4 **WHEREAS**, the available funding totals \$15,196,193. This amount is distributed as follows: Traditional (58 percent) and Expanded Projects (42 percent), and
- 1.5 **WHEREAS**, 81 projects for a total of \$8,801,116 for the Traditional program and 22 projects for a total of \$6,395,077 for the Expanded program were selected for funding, and
- 1.6 **WHEREAS**, if projects are not delivered from the funded list or savings are generated, projects on the contingency list will be selected for funding, and
- 1.7 **WHEREAS**, Caltrans and Commission staff held the required appeals hearing on June 1, 2022, and
- 1.8 **WHEREAS**, the appeals hearing did not result in changes to the 2021 Program of Projects, and

- 1.9 **WHEREAS**, the Commission held the required public hearing prior to adoption.
- 1.10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Commission hereby adopts the attached 2021 Program of Projects for the Federal Transit Administration Section 5310 Enhanced Mobility of Seniors and Individuals with Disabilities Program - Small Urbanized and Rural Area Component, and
- 2.1 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that in adopting the attached 2021 Program of Projects, the Commission hereby directs Caltrans to allocate funds for projects on the approved list down to the level of actual available funding, pursuant to California Government Code Section 14055.2(b).
