Subject: National Motor Vehicle Per-Mile User Fee Pilot Program

Summary:

Barbara Rohde from The Mileage-Based User Fee Alliance will deliver a presentation on the National Motor Vehicle Per-Mile User Fee Pilot Program (Pilot Program), established under Section 13002 of the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act, enacted on November 15, 2021. The Pilot Program aims to demonstrate a national motor vehicle per-mile user fee test, with the objectives of restoring and sustaining the long-term solvency of the Highway Trust Fund and enhancing the integrity of the surface transportation system. Oversight of the Pilot Program will be conducted by the U.S. Department of Transportation in coordination with the Secretary of the Treasury. Furthermore, the presentation will discuss the Mileage-Based User Fee Alliance's essential guidelines for the National Trial Framework.

Background:

Barbara Rohde is the Executive Director of The Mileage-Based User Fee Alliance, which was created as an educational organization to disseminate information on mileage-based user fee projects in the United States and worldwide. Currently, members include state Departments of Transportation, local units of government, various worldwide consulting, tolling and telematics, and research-based organizations. In addition to her work with the Mileage-Based User Fee Alliance, she holds an appointment as a Research Fellow in transportation policy at the Humphrey School at the University of Minnesota.
