



Metrolink operates on seven routes across a six-county, 538 routemiles network.

Commuter rail provides the same capacity as two lanes of parallel freeway traffic.

85% of Metrolink riders have a car but choose to take the train.

Commuter rail is part of a regional solution to ease congestion on all major freeways and connect residents to opportunities.



Metrolink is providing free rides on April 22 for Earth Day, encouraging the use of public transit.
