Subject: RELINQUISHMENT RESOLUTIONS

ISSUE:

Should the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve the California Department of Transportation's (Department) request for relinquishment resolutions that will transfer highway facilities no longer needed for the State Highway System to the local agencies identified in the summary?

RECOMMENDATION:

The Department recommends that the Commission approves the relinquishment resolutions, summarized below, that will transfer highway facilities no longer needed for the State Highway System to the local agencies identified in the summary. It has been determined that each facility in the specific relinquishment resolution summarized below may be disposed of by relinquishment. Upon the recording of the approved relinquishment resolutions in the county where the facilities are located, all rights, title and interest of the State in and to the facilities to be relinquished will be transferred to the local agencies identified in the summary. The facilities are safe and drivable. The local authorities have been advised of the pending relinquishments a minimum of 90 days prior to the Commission meeting pursuant to Section 73 of the Streets and Highways Code. Any exceptions or unusual circumstances are described in the individual summaries.

RESOLUTIONS:

<u>Resolution R-4030 – 03-Nev-49-PM 9.9/11.0</u> (<u>Request No. 035933-X</u>) – 3 <u>Segments</u>

Relinquishes right of way in the county of Nevada (County) along Route 49 on Dalewood Way, Braemer Way, Allison Ranch Road, La Barr Meadows Road and Golden Star Road, consisting of collateral facilities. The County by relinquishment agreement dated March 12, 2009, agreed to accept the relinquishment and by resolution dated May 14, 2019, agreed to waive the

90-day notice requirement and accept title upon relinquishment by the State. See attachment 1A for relinquishment location.

Resolution R-4031 – 04-Ala-84-PM 7.1/10.8 (Request No. 56145) – 1 Segment

Relinquishes right of way in the city of Fremont (City) on Route 84 (Thornton Avenue, Fremont Boulevard, Peralta Boulevard, and Mowry Avenue), under terms and conditions as stated in the relinquishment agreement dated August 19, 2019, determined to be in the best interest of the State. Authorized by Chapter 461, Statutes of 2018, which amended Section 384 of the Streets and Highways Code. See attachment 2A and 2B for relinquishment location.

Resolution R-4032 – 10-SJ-99-PM 9.5/9.8 (Request No. 16560) – 1 Segment

Relinquishes right of way in the county of San Joaquin (County) along Route 99 between West Lathrop Road and Brunswick Road, consisting of collateral facilities. The County by freeway agreement dated November 9, 2010, agreed to accept the relinquishment and by letter signed August 5, 2019, agreed to waive the 90-day notice requirement and accept title upon relinquishment by the State.
