RESOLUTION G-19-48, AMENDING RESOLUTION G-19-32

ISSUE:

Should the California Transportation Commission (Commission) amend the City of Los Angeles' (City) – LA River Greenway, West San Fernando Valley Gap Closure project (Project)(PPNO 5663), currently programmed in the 2019 Active Transportation Program (ATP), to allow the City to move \$300,000 in Plans, Specifications and Estimates (PS&E) and \$400,000 in Right of Way (RW), both currently programmed in Fiscal Year 2019-20, to 2021-22 for Construction (CON)?

RECOMMENDATION:

The California Department of Transportation (Department) recommends the Commission approve the City's amendment for the Project (PPNO 5663), currently programmed in the 2019 ATP, to allow the City to move \$300,000 in PS&E and \$400,000 in RW, both currently programmed in Fiscal Year 2019-20, to 2021-22 for CON.

BACKGROUND:

On May 16, 2019, the Commission approved the Metropolitan component of the 2019 ATP (Resolution G-19-32), which included \$18,793,000 in 2019 ATP funding for the City's Project (PPNO 5663).

The 2019 ATP Guidelines, adopted by the Commission on May 16, 2018, state that funding distribution changes will be considered for ATP projects to allow agencies to move funds between programmed phases provided that moving funds between phases does not increase the total funding amount programmed. The proposed amendment for this 2019 ATP, Project (PPNO 5663), would move funds as outlined in the chart below, and does not program additional funding for the project.
