Subject: ALLOCATION FOR LOCALLY-ADMINISTERED STIP PROJECTS OFF THE STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM RESOLUTION FP-19-27

ISSUE:

Should the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve an allocation of \$1,379,000 for five locally-administered State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) projects, off the State Highway System?

RECOMMENDATION:

The California Department of Transportation recommends that the Commission approve an allocation of \$1,379,000 for five locally-administered STIP projects as follows:

2.5c.(3a) - \$1,255,000 for three STIP projects and

2.5c.(3b) - \$124,000 for two STIP Planning, Programming, and Monitoring projects.

BACKGROUND:

The attached vote list describes five locally-administered STIP projects totaling \$1,379,000. The local agencies are ready to proceed with these projects, and are requesting an allocation at this time.

FINANCIAL RESOLUTION:

Resolved that \$1,379,000 be allocated from the Budget Act of 2018, Budget Act Items 2660-101-0042 for five locally-administered STIP projects described on the attached vote list.
