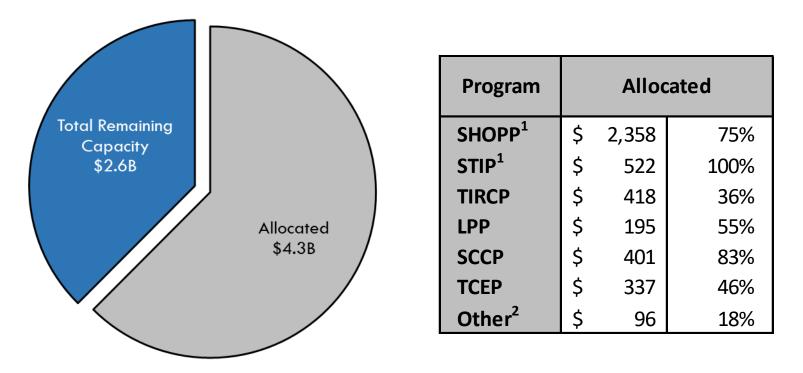

G-12 Progress Report through March (2018-19)

- G-12's represent delegated authority to make adjustments (increases or decreases) to project funding.
- Through March 2019, Caltrans has processed the following changes:
 - SHOPP: Approximately \$78 million in increases from 113 projects, and over \$182 million in savings from 195 projects.
 - STIP: Approximately \$3 million in increases from 3 projects, and \$19,000 in savings from 3 projects.
