Subject: RESCINDING RESOLUTIONS OF NECESSITY

<u>ISSUE:</u>

Should the California Transportation Commission (Commission) adopt Resolutions of Necessity (Resolutions) CR-163 and CR-164, rescinding Resolutions C-21441 and C-21444, because condemnation lawsuits were never filed under the authority of the adopted Resolutions?

RECOMMENDATION:

The California Department of Transportation (Department) recommends the Commission adopt Resolutions CR-163 and CR-164. In accordance with Department requirements, the owners have been advised that the Department is requesting rescission of Resolutions C-21441 and C-21444 as summarized below.

BACKGROUND:

Resolutions C-21441 and C-21444 were adopted by the Commission on March 16, 2016 for Segment 13 of the State Route (SR) 138 widening project in Los Angeles County. These Resolutions authorized condemnation of land in fee for State highway purposes and underlying fee. Subsequent to the adoption of these Resolutions, funding for the project was withdrawn. As such, the Department cancelled all activities associated with the project, including condemnation. Based on the above, it is requested that these Resolutions be rescinded because the Department never filed condemnation lawsuits under the authority of the adopted Resolutions.



PARCEL 76490-1:

For State Highway purposes, that portion of Parcel 2, in the County of Los Angeles, State of California as conveyed in a deed recorded September 22, 2005 as Instrument No. 05-2284715, Official Records, in the Office of the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk of said county, described as follows:

Part "A"

All that land lying Northerly of the following described line:


