Subject: <u>STIP AMENDMENT 18S-21</u> <u>SAN DIEGO COUNTY – PPNO 1406</u>

SUMMARY:

The California Department of Transportation (Department) will request that the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve the requested program amendment at the next scheduled Commission meeting following the notice period.

The San Diego Association of Governments (SANDAG) proposes to program \$1,000,000 of Federal Safe, Accountable, Flexible, Efficient Transportation Equity Act: A Legacy for Users (SAFETEA-LU) Border Infrastructure Program (BIP) funds for the Northbound Border Wait Time (BWT) Data Collection System for the San Ysidro and Otay Mesa Ports of Entry (POE) project (PPNO 1406) in San Diego County. The Department concurs with this proposal.

BACKGROUND:

SAFETEA-LU, enacted in August 2005, authorizes funding through the BIP to improve transportation at international borders and ports of entry, and within trade corridors. Since the enactment of SAFETEA-LU, California has received a total apportionment of \$188 million in BIP funding. To date, approximately \$173 million has been committed to eligible border region projects in the State.

It is proposed to program \$1,000,000 of remaining BIP funds for the Northbound BWT Data Collection System for the San Ysidro POE and the Otay Mesa POE project, which consists of developing and installing a system to collect wait time data of commercial and private vehicles

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crossing the border into San Diego from Tijuana. The system includes installing field elements in Mexico, developing, as well as validating, corresponding algorithms, and maintaining the system for 12 to 24 months. The project will measure wait times of northbound traffic at the San Ysidro and Otay Mesa POEs for both passenger and commercial vehicles. The project will complement the currently programmed Senate Bill 1 Trade Corridor Enhancement Program project, which includes installing a Southbound BWT system for traffic traveling south from California to Mexico.

The project will gather information about the border wait times at the San Ysidro and Otay Mesa POEs to provide information for both the upcoming Investment Grade Traffic and Revenue Study for the proposed Otay Mesa POE project, future Border Master Plans, Border Delay Economic Impact Studies and the Future Regional Transportation Plan for the Region.

Pursuant to Section 164.1 of the California Streets and Highways Code, BIP funds shall be programmed, allocated, and expended in the same manner as other federal funds made available for capital improvement projects in the State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP). These BIP funds are eligible in a border region, defined as any portion of a border state within 100 miles of an international land border with Canada or Mexico, for the following types of improvements to facilitate/expedite cross-border motor vehicle and cargo movements:

- Improvements to existing transportation and supporting infrastructure.
- Construction of highways and related safety and safety enforcement facilities related to international trade.
- Operation improvements, including those related to electronic data interchange and use of telecommunications.
- Modifications to regulatory procedures.
- International coordination of transportation planning, programming, and border operation with Canada and Mexico.

The proposed funding plan is as follows:
