Subject: ALLOCATION FOR TRANSIT AND INTERCITY RAIL CAPITAL PROGRAM PROJECTS RESOLUTION TIRCP-1920-02

ISSUE:

Should the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve an allocation of \$76,131,000 for four Transit and Intercity Rail Capital Program (TIRCP) projects?

RECOMMENDATION:

The California Department of Transportation recommends that the Commission approve an allocation of \$76,131,000 for four TIRCP projects as follows:

2.6g.(1b) - \$76,131,000 for four TIRCP projects (SB1 Augmentation for PTA).

BACKGROUND:

The attached vote list describes four TIRCP projects totaling \$76,131,000. The local agencies are ready to proceed with these projects, and are requesting an allocation at this time.

FINANCIAL RESOLUTION:

Resolved that \$76,131,000 be allocated from the Budget Act of 2018, Budget Act Items 2660-101-0046 and 2660-301-0046R for four TIRCP projects described on the attached vote list.
