### **ISSUE:**

Should the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve an allocation of \$16,489,000 for the locally-administered Multi-Funded Proposition 1B Trade Corridors Improvement Fund (TCIF)/State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) ACE: Avenue 66/UP Railroad Grade Separation Bypass project (PPNO 1189), off the State Highway System, in Riverside County?

### **RECOMMENDATION:**

The California Department of Transportation recommends that the Commission approve an allocation of \$16,489,000 for the locally-administered Multi-Funded TCIF/STIP ACE: Avenue 66/UP Railroad Grade Separation Bypass project (PPNO 1189), off the State Highway System, in Riverside County.

### **BACKGROUND:**

The attached vote list describes the locally-administered Multi-Funded TCIF/STIP project totaling \$16,489,000. The local agency is ready to proceed with this project, and is requesting an allocation at this time; however, the allocation is contingent on the approval of a budget revision by the Department of Finance.

### **FINANCIAL RESOLUTION:**

Resolved that \$16,489,000 be allocated from the Budget Act of 2018 and 2019, Budget Act Items 2660-104-6056 and 2660-101-0890 for the locally-administered Multi-Funded TCIF/STIP project described on the attached vote list.
