## Subject: ALLOCATION FOR LOCALLY-ADMINISTERED SENATE BILL 1 LOCAL PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM (FORMULAIC) TRANSIT PROJECTS RESOLUTION LPP-A-1920-03

#### ISSUE:
