### **ISSUE:**

Should the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve an allocation of \$102,000 for the locally-administered Active Transportation Program (ATP) South Chester Avenue Pedestrian Safety Project (PPNO 6997), in Kern County, programmed in Fiscal Year 2020-21?

### **RECOMMENDATION:**

The California Department of Transportation recommends that the Commission defer an allocation of \$102,000 for the locally-administered ATP South Chester Avenue Pedestrian Safety Project (PPNO 6997), in Kern County, programmed in 2020-21 because this project is advanced from a future year program.

### **BACKGROUND:**

The attached vote list describes the locally-administered ATP project totaling \$102,000. Although the local agency is ready to proceed with this project, it is recommended that the Commission defer this allocation.
