Subject: S.A.F.E. Vehicle Rule Update

Summary:

Tanisha Taylor, Director of Sustainability with the California Association of Councils of Governments will provide an update on the Safer Affordable Fuel-Efficient (S.A.F.E.) Vehicles Rule.

Background:

In August 2018, the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration proposed the S.A.F.E. Vehicle Rule to roll back national fuel efficiency standards and invalidate California's clean car standards and electric vehicle mandates. Part one of the S.A.F.E. Rule became effective November 26, 2019; Part two is anticipated to be finalized this Spring.

Ms. Taylor will provide an update on the S.A.F.E. Rule and discuss potential impacts on regional transportation planning and transportation project delivery.
