Subject: RELINQUISHMENT RESOLUTIONS

ISSUE:

Should the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve the California Department of Transportation's (Department) request for relinquishment resolutions that will transfer highway facilities no longer needed for the State Highway System to the local agencies identified in the summary?

RECOMMENDATION:

The Department recommends that the Commission approves the relinquishment resolutions, summarized below, that will transfer highway facilities no longer needed for the State Highway System to the local agencies identified in the summary. It has been determined that each facility in the specific relinquishment resolution summarized below may be disposed of by relinquishment. Upon the recording of the approved relinquishment resolutions in the county where the facilities are located, all rights, title and interest of the State in and to the facilities to be relinquished will be transferred to the local agencies identified in the summary. The facilities are safe and drivable. The local authorities have been advised of the pending relinquishments a minimum of 90 days before the Commission meeting pursuant to Section 73 of the Streets and Highways Code. Any exceptions or unusual circumstances are described in the individual summaries.

RESOLUTIONS:

Resolution R-4036 – 03-Pla-193-PM 1.35/2.57
(Request No. 037751-X) – 1 Segment

Relinquishes right of way in the city of Lincoln (City) on Route 193 under the terms and conditions as stated in the relinquishment agreement dated January 30, 2020, determined to be in the best interest of the State. Authorized by Chapter 629, Statutes of 2019, which

*“Provide a safe, sustainable, integrated and efficient transportation system
to enhance California’s economy and livability”*

amended Section 493 of the Streets and Highways Code. See Attachment 1 for the relinquishment location.

Resolution R-4033 – 04-SF-101-PM 0.7
(Request No. 56146) – 1 Segment

Relinquishes right of way, consisting of collateral facilities, in the city and county of San Francisco (City) along Route 101 at 3rd Street. The City and County, by City Ordinance No. 13-20 signed by the Mayor on February 14, 2020, agreed to waive the 90-day notice requirement and accept title upon relinquishment by the State. See Attachment 2 for the relinquishment location.

Resolution R-4037 – 10-Sta-99-PM R21.4/R22.0
(Request No. 17140) – 2 Segments

Relinquishes right of way, consisting of collateral facilities, in the city of Modesto (City) along Route 99 on Salida Boulevard and Pelandale Avenue. The City, by Resolution No. 2019-489 dated November 5, 2019, agreed to waive the 90-day notice requirement and accept title upon relinquishment by the State. See Attachment 3 for the relinquishment location.

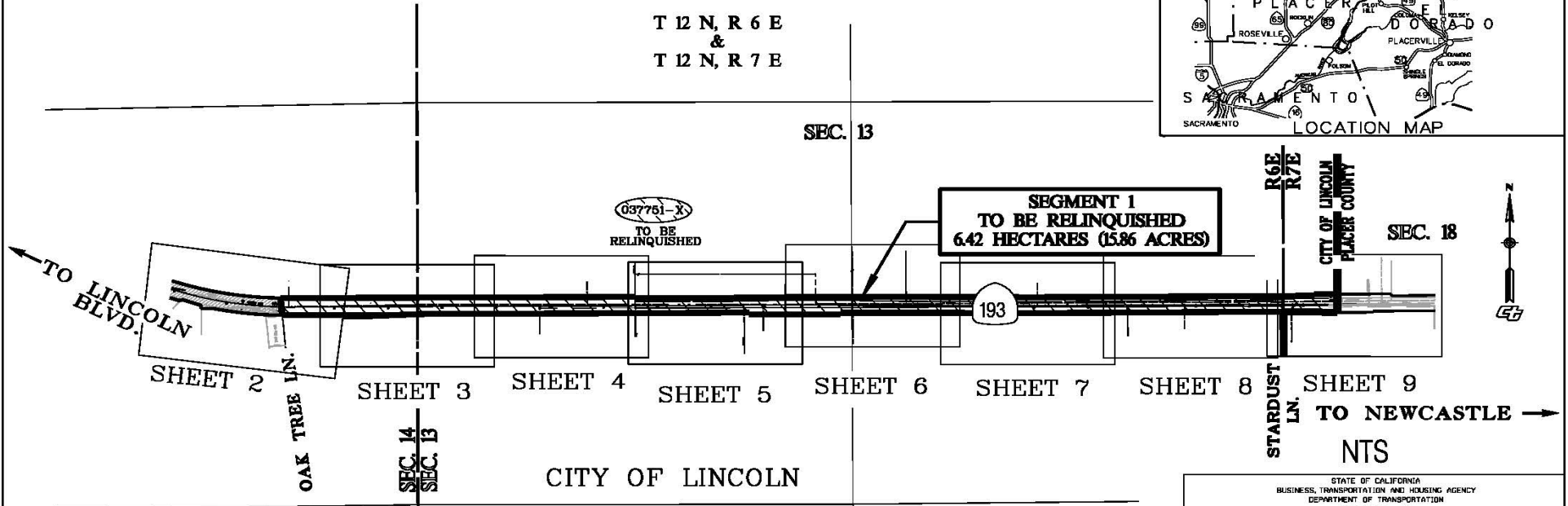
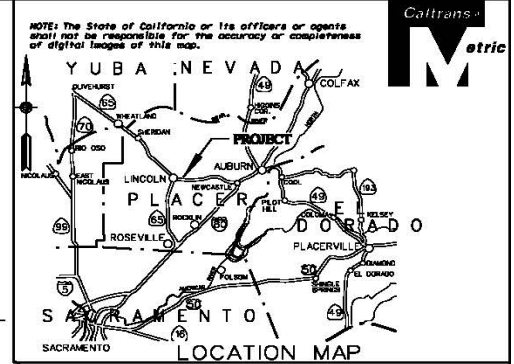

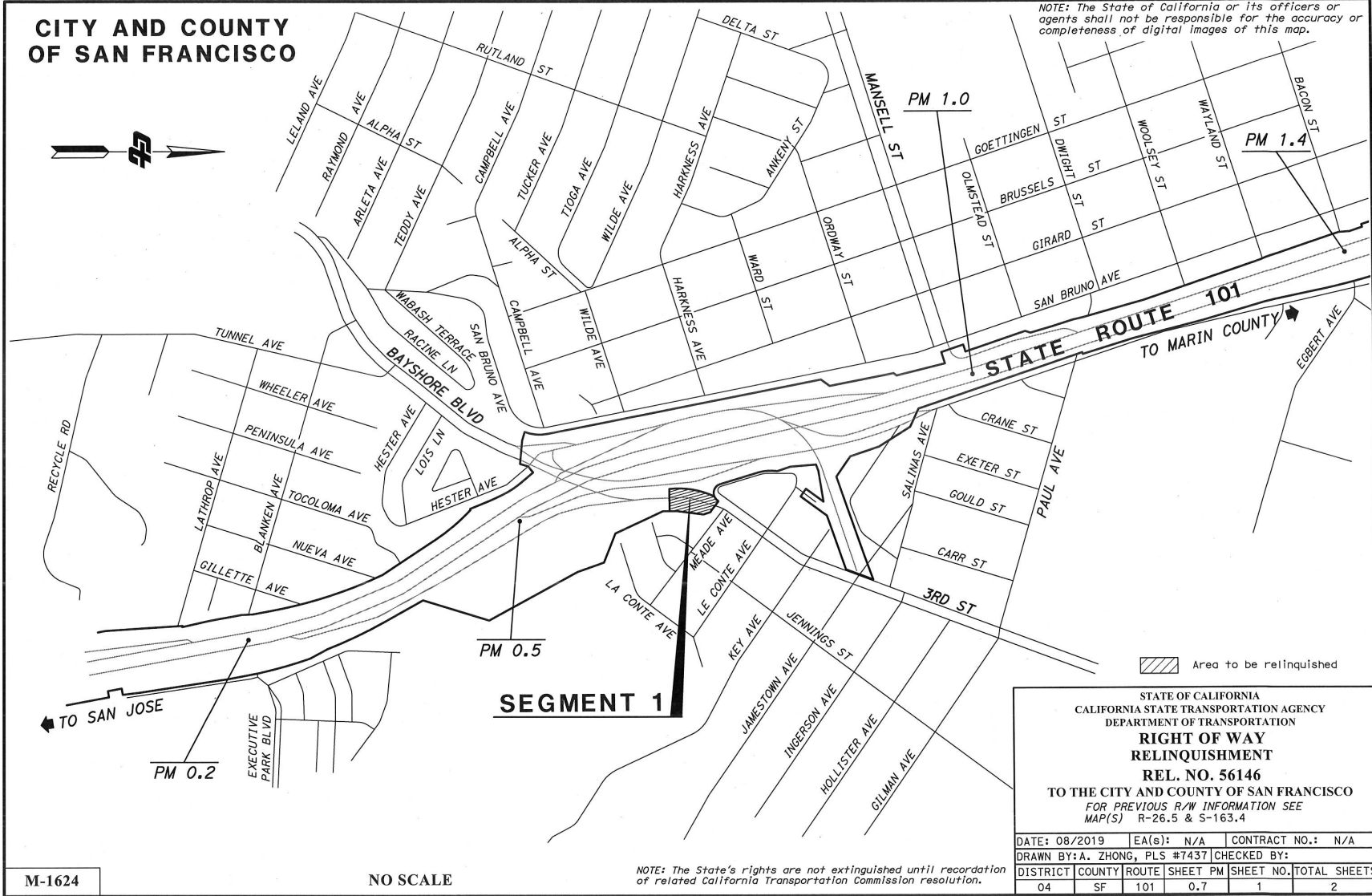
