RESOLUTION FP-19-66**

ISSUE:

Should the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve an allocation of \$9,240,000 for the State-Administered State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) SR70 Passing Lanes (Segment 2) project (PPNO 9801A), on the State Highway System, in Butte County, programmed in Fiscal Year 2020-21?

RECOMMENDATION:

The California Department of Transportation recommends that the Commission approve an allocation of \$9,240,000 for the State-Administered STIP SR70 Passing Lanes (Segment 2) project (PPNO 9801A), on the State Highway System, in Butte County, programmed in 2020-21.

BACKGROUND:

The attached vote list describes the State-Administered STIP project totaling \$9,240,000. The Department is ready to proceed with this project, and is requesting an allocation at this time.

FINANCIAL RESOLUTION:

Resolved that \$8,040,000 be allocated from the Budget Act of 2018, Budget Act Item 2660-301-0042 for construction and \$1,200,000 for construction engineering for the State-Administered STIP project described on the attached vote list.
