Issue:

Trade Corridors Improvement Program Project Baseline Agreements for the Metro Air Parkways Northbound Auxiliary Lane Project in Sacramento County and State Route 60 Central Avenue Interchange Project in San Bernardino County are being brought before the Commission for approval.
