Subject: ALLOCATION FOR LOCALLY-ADMINISTERED STIP PROJECTS OFF THE STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM RESOLUTION FP-19-97

ISSUE:

Should the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve an allocation of \$12,914,000 for seven locally-administered State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) projects, off the State Highway System?

RECOMMENDATION:

The California Department of Transportation recommends that the Commission approve an allocation of \$12,914,000 for seven locally-administered STIP projects as follows:

2.5c.(3a) - \$12,914,000 for seven STIP projects

BACKGROUND:

The attached vote list describes seven locally-administered STIP projects totaling \$12,914,000. The local agencies are ready to proceed with these projects, and are requesting an allocation at this time.

FINANCIAL RESOLUTION:

Resolved that \$12,914,000 be allocated from the Budget Act of 2018, Budget Act Items 2660-101-0042 and 2660-101-0890 for seven locally-administered STIP projects described on the attached vote list.
