ISSUE:

Should the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve an allocation of \$15,350,000 for two locally-administered Senate Bill 1 (SB 1) Local Partnership Program (LPP) (Formulaic) projects, on the State Highway System, programmed in Fiscal Year 2020-21?

RECOMMENDATION:

The California Department of Transportation recommends that the Commission approve an allocation of \$15,350,000 for two locally-administered SB 1 LPP (Formulaic) projects, on the State Highway System, programmed in 2020-21.

BACKGROUND:

The attached vote list describes two locally-administered SB 1 LPP (Formulaic) projects, totaling \$15,350,000. The local agencies are ready to proceed with these projects, and are requesting an allocation at this time.

FINANCIAL RESOLUTION:
