Subject: ALLOCATION FOR LOCALLY-ADMINISTERED SENATE BILL 1 LOCAL PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM (FORMULAIC/COMPETITIVE) MASS TRANSIT PROJECTS RESOLUTION LPP-A-1920-22

ISSUE:

Should the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve an allocation of \$15,241,000 for two locally-administered Senate Bill 1 (SB 1) Local Partnership Program (LPP) (Formulaic/Competitive) Mass Transit projects?

RECOMMENDATION:

The California Department of Transportation recommends that the Commission approve an allocation of \$15,241,000 for two locally-administered SB 1 LPP (Formulaic/Competitive) Mass Transit projects as follows:

2.6s.(1a) - \$241,000 for one LPP (Formulaic) project and 2.6s.(1b) - \$15,000,000 for one LPP (Competitive) project.

BACKGROUND:

The attached vote list describes two locally-administered SB 1 LPP (Formulaic/Competitive) Mass Transit projects totaling \$15,241,000. The local agencies are ready to proceed with these projects, and are requesting an allocation at this time.

FINANCIAL RESOLUTION:

Resolved that \$15,241,000 be allocated from Non-Budget Act Item 2660-601-3290 for two locally-administered SB 1 LPP (Formulaic/Competitive) Mass Transit projects as described on the attached vote list.
