Subject: REQUEST TO AMEND EXTEND THE PERIOD OF PROJECT ALLOCATION FOR PREVIOUSLY APPROVED TIME EXTENSIONS FOR STATE HIGHWAY OPERATION AND PROTECTION PROGRAM (SHOPP) PROJECTS, PER THE INTERIM TIMELY USE OF FUNDS POLICY FOR SHOPP PROJECTS WAIVER 20-66

ISSUE:

Should the California Transportation Commission (Commission) amend the period of project allocation for two State Highway Operation and Protection Program (SHOPP) projects totaling \$16,854,000, as shown on the attachment?

RECOMMENDATION:

The California Department of Transportation (Department) recommends that the Commission amend the period of project allocation for two SHOPP projects totaling \$16,854,000 (\$10,068,000 in construction, \$2,036,000 in construction engineering and \$4,750,000 in preconstruction phases), as shown on the attachment.

BACKGROUND:

The Department will not be able to request an allocation of funds by the June 30, 2020 deadline due to the impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic.

Current SHOPP Guidelines stipulate that the Commission may approve waivers to the timely use of funds deadline one-time only for up to 20 months in accordance with Government Code Section 14529.8.

In May 2020, the Commission adopted the proposed 2020 Interim SHOPP Timely Use of Funds Policy, under Resolution G-20-57, to mitigate the impacts the pandemic could have on project delivery. This interim policy is effective through December 2020 and if necessary, Commission staff will revisit the interim policy at the December 2020 Commission Meeting.
