Subject: <u>STIP AMENDMENT 18S-23</u> <u>PPNO 0999B – SAN DIEGO COUNTY</u>

ISSUE:

Should the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve the requested State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) Amendment 18S-23?

RECOMMENDATION:

The California Department of Transportation (Department) will request that the Commission approve the requested STIP Amendment 18S-23. This item was noticed at the Commission's May 2020 meeting.

The Department proposes to amend the State Route 11 – Commercial Vehicle Enforcement Facility (CVEF) and Tolling/Border Wait Time System Project – Segment 2 (PPNO 0999B) in San Diego County as follows:

 Segment the project to split the CVEF Design, construction, and Site Preparation construction from the project and program \$2,500,000 of Fixing America's Surface Transportation Act (FAST Act) Surface Transportation Block Grant Program (STBGP) -Coordinated Border Infrastructure Program (CBI) funds to the new Segment 2C project under PPNO 0999G.

BACKGROUND:

Pursuant to Section 164.1 of the California Streets and Highways Code, CBI funds shall be programmed, allocated, and expended in the same manner as other federal funds made available for capital improvement projects in the STIP. Accordingly, Commission action is necessary to amend projects which are programmed with Border Infrastructure Program (BIP) funding.

"Provide a safe, sustainable, integrated and efficient transportation system to enhance California's economy and livability"

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The CVEF construction and Tolling/Border Wait Time System Project will be located 2.5 miles east of the existing Otay Mesa Port of Entry along the Unites States/Mexico border. When this project is completed, it is expected to decrease wait times and border traffic congestion by adding capacity to the regional border crossing infrastructure and creating a link between the US regional highway system and the Mexico free and toll road systems. This link will maintain the economic viability of goods movement through the California/Baja California region.

This venture will create a 21st century Port of Entry that will enhance border efficiency, fuel economic growth, and reduce truck greenhouse gas emissions. These Improvements will also provide a fast, predictable and innovative border crossing by constructing a state-of-the art California Highway Patrol CVEF. The purpose of CVEF is to ensure that the roads are not compromised by potentially overweight vehicles and to improve the safety and security of the traveling public. Currently, BIP and CBI funds are programmed for the Plans, Specifications & Estimate (PS&E) and Right of Way (R/W) phases for the Segment 2 project.

The FAST Act specifies that any eligible project under the CBI program is eligible under the STBGP. Federal law allows that each state may set-aside up to 5 percent of its "any-area" STBGP funds for the CBI. The Department has set-aside \$16 million per year for CBI projects, to be reserved from the State's share of "any-area" STBGP funds, this funding is reflected in the 2020 STIP Fund Estimate approved by the Commission in August 2019.

This amendment proposes to:

- PPNO 0999B Revise the scope of Segment 2 to remove the CVEF Design, construction and Site Preparation construction from this project. After this revision, the title for this project will be Tolling/Border Wait Time System for design and construction.
- PPNO 0999G Add a new project as Segment 2C and program \$2,500,000 for PS&E with the STBGP CBI funds for the CVEF Design, construction and Site Preparation construction. This project; Segment 2C, is being split out from Segment 2 (PPNO 0999B) to facilitate project delivery of this child project.
