<u>lssue:</u>

State Route 99 Bond Program Project Baseline Agreements for the Tulare City Widening Project in Tulare County, the South Madera 6 Lane Project in Madera County, and the Plainsburg-Arboleda Mitigation Project in Merced County are being brought before the Commission for approval. These three Baseline Agreements are in accordance with the Commission's State Route 99 Bond Program Guidelines, and approval will establish the basis for project delivery and monitoring.

Staff has reviewed the Baseline Agreements and determined the expected benefits, delivery schedules, cost and funding plans are consistent with the project which the Commission approved.

Background:
