Subject: AB 608 ADJUSTMENTS FOR A STIP PROJECT

RESOLUTION FP-20-30, AMENDING RESOLUTION FP-19-63

ISSUE:

Should the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve an adjustments to the State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP)- Interregional Improvement Program (IIP) and Regional Improvement Program (RIP) allocation amounts for the Eureka/Arcata Restoration for Mitigation project (PPNO 2389) in Humboldt County?

RECOMMENDATION:

The California Department of Transportation (Department) recommends the Commission approve adjustments to the STIP-IIP and STIP-RIP allocation amounts for the Eureka/Arcata Restoration for Mitigation project (PPNO 2389) in Humboldt County.

BACKGROUND:

At the March 2020 meeting, the Commission approved Resolution FP-19-63 to allocate \$4,610,000 in STIP-IIP and \$2,428,000 in STIP-RIP funds to construction for the Eureka/Arcata Restoration for Mitigation project. The construction contract was awarded on July 1, 2020 with savings of \$1,943,000 in STIP-IIP funds and \$1,023,000 in STIP-RIP funds.

Section 188.8 of the Streets and Highways Code, amended by Assembly Bill 608, allows the Commission to adjust an allocation amount, for a capital outlay project in the STIP, if the construction contract award amount for the project is less than 80 percent of the engineer's final estimate. The result would be an adjustment to interregional and/or county shares. The legislation is permissive, and it is understood that adjustments to allocations are at the discretion of the Commission.

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Therefore, Department and Humboldt County Association of Governments are requesting a downward adjustment of \$1,943,000 to Interregional shares and \$1,023,000 to Humboldt County's regional shares for the Eureka/Arcata Restoration for Mitigation project, in accordance with Assembly Bill 608.
