Subject: **STATE ROUTE 710 NORTH STUB RELINQUISHMENT UPDATE**

SUMMARY:

The California Department of Transportation (Department) will be presenting an overview of the proposed relinquishment of State Route (SR) 710 North Stub to the California Transportation Commission (Commission) at the January 2022 meeting, as an informational item.

BACKGROUND:

In September 2019, Senate Bill 7 and Assembly Bill 29 legislation established that subject to an agreement and determination by the Commission, the SR 710 North Stub may be relinquished to the City of Pasadena (City). The proposed relinquishment is intended to strengthen transportation-land use connections by turning over a portion of a state roadway infrastructure to local ownership and control. The relinquishment is only for the roadway infrastructure portions of the 710 stub and does not include conveying any single or multi-family homes to the City. This is the first of a series of steps to provide the City the opportunity to reconnect their community. The City and the Department have been collaboratively taking steps to complete the relinquishment process.
