Highway 99 Bridges

Replaced, Retrofit, and Rehabilitated 5 Bridges in and near Elk Grove along SR 99.

Construction Manager/General Contractor (CMGC) project.

Elk Grove

COSUMNES RIVER BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT

Location: State Route 99, south of Elk Grove, mile marker 7.1-9.4

Governing agency: Caltrans

Construction cost: \$158M

McConnell Underpass/Overhead: A new overpass will be built so both lanes of SR 99 will go over the railroad track.

Cosumnes River Bridge: Northbound and southbound bridges will be replaced with one bridge for all four lanes of traffic.

Cosumnes River Overflow Bridge: Northbound and southbound bridges will be replaced with one bridge for all four lanes of traffic.

HOV Lanes in Carpinteria



- 5.8 lane miles of HOV lanes in each direction
- 4 out of 11 reconstructed bridges to date
- Part of a larger vision to extend HOV lanes through the County.
