### **ISSUE:**

Should the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve an allocation of \$175,000,000 for the locally-administered Senate Bill 1 (SB 1) Trade Corridor Enhancement Program (TCEP) 7th Street Grade Separation (East) project (PPNO 2103D), off the State Highway System, in Alameda County?

#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

The California Department of Transportation recommends that the Commission approve an allocation of \$175,000,000 for the locally-administered SB 1 TCEP 7th Street Grade Separation (East) project (PPNO 2103D), off the State Highway System, in Alameda County.

### **BACKGROUND:**

The attached vote list describes the locally-administered SB 1 TCEP project totaling \$175,000,000. The local agency is ready to proceed with this project, and is requesting an allocation at this time.

### **FINANCIAL RESOLUTION:**

Resolved that \$175,000,000 be allocated from the Budget Act of 2020 and 2022, Budget Act Item 2660-101-3291 for the locally-administered SB 1 TCEP project described on the attached vote list.
