Subject: Approval of Project for Future Funding Consideration – Mitigated Negative

Declaration for the Western Extension of Tracks - Brea Rail Trail Project,

Resolution E-22-103

Recommendation:

Staff recommends the California Transportation Commission (Commission), as a Responsible Agency, accept the Mitigated Negative Declaration for the Western Extension of Tracks – Brea Rail Trail Project (Project) in Orange County and approve the Project for future funding consideration.

Issue:

The City of Brea (City) is the California Environmental Quality Act lead agency for the Project. The Project will construct a Class I multi-use path, including lighting, fencing, and landscaping. The Project is located along the Union Pacific Railroad property between Palm Street and Berry Street in the City of Brea, in Orange County.

For all projects that are anticipated to be funded through a program under the purview of the Commission, full compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act is required. The Commission will not allocate funds to projects for design, right-of-way, or construction until the environmental document is complete, and the Commission has approved the environmentally cleared project for future funding consideration.

Background:

On May 3, 2018, the Brea City Council adopted the Mitigated Negative Declaration for the Project and found that the Project would not have a significant effect on the environment after mitigation.

Impacts that require mitigation measures to be reduced to less than significant levels relate to aesthetics, geology, hazardous materials, and water quality. Mitigation measures include the following: provide adequate fencing to maintain the area free of graffiti, contract with a registered professional engineer to address potential expansive soil impacts, comply with the

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requirements established by the Hazardous Material Assessment and Limited Phase II Environmental Site Assessment, and prepare a Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan.

On October 13, 2022, the City confirmed that the Mitigated Negative Declaration remains valid and that there are no new identified impacts requiring mitigation. The City also confirmed that the preferred alternative set forth in the final environmental document is consistent with the Project scope of work programmed by the Commission.

The Project is fully funded through design with Active Transportation Program Funds – Cycle V (\$1,787,000) and Local Funds (\$1,000,000).

Construction is estimated to begin in Fiscal Year 2025-26.

- 1.8 WHEREAS, on October 13, 2022, the City also confirmed that the preferred alternative set forth in the Mitigated Negative Declaration is consistent with the Project scope of work programmed by the Commission; and
- 1.9 WHEREAS, the Commission, as a Responsible Agency, has considered the information contained in the Mitigated Negative Declaration.
- 2.1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Commission does hereby accept the Mitigated Negative Declaration and approves the above-referenced Project for future funding consideration.


