OFF THE STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM

RESOLUTION FP-22-35

ISSUE:

Should the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve an allocation of \$4,451,000 for seven locally-administered State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) projects, off the State Highway System?

RECOMMENDATION:

The California Department of Transportation recommends that the Commission approve an allocation of \$4,451,000 for seven locally-administered STIP projects as follows:

2.5c.(3a) - \$4,154,000 for four STIP projects.

2.5c.(3b) - \$297,000 for three STIP Planning, Programming, and Monitoring projects.

BACKGROUND:

The attached vote list describes seven locally-administered STIP projects totaling \$4,451,000. The local agencies are ready to proceed with these projects, and are requesting an allocation at this time.

FINANCIAL RESOLUTION:

Resolved that \$4,451,000 be allocated from the Budget Act of 2021, Budget Act Items 2660-101-0042 and 2660-101-0890 for seven locally-administered STIP projects described on the attached vote list.
