Subject: Local Partnership Formulaic Program Amendment, Resolution LPP-P-2223-06, Amending Resolution LPP-P-2223-05

Recommendation:

Staff recommends the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve an amendment to the Local Partnership Formulaic Program with the following actions:

- Delete the Richmond Street Curb, Signing, Marking Improvements Project in Contra Costa County and make the funding available to reprogram and allocate until June 30, 2023.
- Add the Oakland Alameda Access Project in Alameda County and program \$196,000 in fiscal year 2022-23.
- Add the Ingomar Grade Rehabilitation Project in Merced County and program \$786,000 in fiscal year 2022-23.
- Add the Lincoln Boulevard Rehabilitation Project in Merced County and program \$800,000 in fiscal year 2022-23.
- Add the El Cerrito del Norte Transit-Oriented Development Complete Streets Improvements Project in Contra Costa County and program \$400,000 in fiscal year 2022-23.
- Amend the State Route 132 Phase 2: Four-lane Expressway from Dakota Avenue to Needham Street Project in Stanislaus County and program \$3,217,000 to the Right-of-Way phase in fiscal year 2022-23.
- Amend the Truckee Railyard Transit Center Phase 1 Project in Nevada County and:
 - o deprogram \$400,000 from the Right-of-Way phase in fiscal year 2021-22, and
 - o program \$400,000 to the Construction phase in fiscal year 2022-23.

The eight recommended amendments are consistent with the Local Partnership Formulaic Program Guidelines.

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<u>lssue:</u>

Commission staff reviewed each request to amend the Local Partnership Formulaic Program. The amendment requests are summarized below:

- The Alameda County Transportation Commission requests to add the Oakland Alameda Access Project in Alameda County and program \$196,000 of its available 2020 Formulaic Program funding to the Right-of-Way phase in fiscal year 2022-23. This project will provide active transportation facilities, pedestrian and bicyclist safety enhancements, realignment of offramps and onramps to address circulation issues, as well as other roadway improvements. The anticipated benefits of this project include improved multimodal mobility and accessibility between the cities of Oakland and Alameda and easing local roadway congestion around Interstate 880 and State Route 260.
- The Merced County Transportation Authority requests to add two projects in Merced County and program the remainder of its available 2020 Formulaic Program funding as follows:
 - Add the Ingomar Grade Rehabilitation Project and program \$786,000 to the Construction phase in fiscal year 2022-23. This project will rehabilitate Ingomar Grade Road to restore failing pavement. The anticipated benefits of this project include improved safety and increasing the current pavement condition index.
 - Add the Lincoln Boulevard Rehabilitation Project and program \$800,000 to the Construction phase in fiscal year 2022-23. This project will rehabilitate Lincoln Boulevard from State Route 140 to Livingston City to restore failing pavement. The anticipated benefits of this project include improved safety and increasing the current pavement condition index.
- The City of El Cerrito requests to delete one project and add a new project as follows:
 - Delete the Richmond Street Curb, Signing, Marking Improvements Project in Contra Costa County and deprogram \$400,000 from the Construction phase in fiscal year 2022-23. This project was programmed with 2020 Formulaic Program funding at the December 2020 Commission meeting. This project is planned to start work after the completion of the Wildcat Pipeline Project, a major East Bay Municipal Utility District transmission pipeline project. The Wildcat Pipeline Project has experienced several delays, and the construction schedule is now in direct conflict with the City of El Cerrito's Richmond Street Project. The Wildcat Pipeline Project anticipates completion in the Fall 2025, at which time the City of El Cerrito can start work. This timeframe is outside the 2020 Formulaic Program schedule, therefore the City of El Cerrito requests deleting this project from the 2020 Formulaic Program.
 - Add the El Cerrito del Norte Transit-Oriented Development Complete Streets Improvements Project and program \$400,000 to the Construction phase in fiscal year 2022-23. This project will implement multimodal transportation improvements to support transit-oriented development including construction of

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enhanced and new protected crosswalks, new context-sensitive bikeways, and bus boarding islands. The anticipated benefits of this project include improved access, circulation, safety, and streetscape elements for bicyclists, pedestrians, and transit users.

- The Stanislaus County Transportation Authority, requests to add funding to the State Route 132 Phase 2: Four-lane Expressway from Dakota Avenue to Needham Street Project in Stanislaus County and program \$3,217,000 of its available 2020 Formulaic Program funding to the Right-of-Way phase in fiscal year 2022-23. This project received an allocation of 2019 Formulaic Program funds for the Plans, Specifications, and Estimate phase at the June 2021 Commission meeting. This project will add two lanes to the existing two-lane expressway to create a four-lane facility from Needham Street to Dakota Avenue. In addition, this project will construct freeway connectors from State Route 132 to State Route 99 and construct a partial interchange at Carpenter Road. The anticipated benefits of this project include safety improvements, congestion reduction, and improved goods movement to and from the Port of Oakland.
- The Town of Truckee requests to amend the Truckee Railyard Transit Center Phase 1 Project in Nevada County with the following actions:
 - Deprogram \$400,000 in 2020 Formulaic Program funding from the Right-of-Way phase in fiscal year 2021-22. The implementing agency, Town of Truckee, completed the Right-of-Way phase with local funds. The Right-of-Way funds were programmed to this project at the January 2022 Commission meeting; in addition, the Town of Truckee received approval of an allocation time extension to June 30, 2023.
 - Add \$400,000 in 2020 Formulaic Program funding to the Construction phase in fiscal year 2022-23. This project will construct pavement, transit vehicle pull-outs, electric vehicle charging infrastructure, sidewalks, transit shelters and bike racks. The phase 1 project has independent utility and will allow for transit operations to transition to this new Railyard Transit Center. The anticipated benefits of this project include safety improvements, congestion relief, and meeting the increasing demand for transit options.

The Local Partnership Formulaic Program has programmed 185 projects totaling \$633 million since 2018. This action leaves \$38.9 million of the 2020 Local Partnership Formulaic Program funding available for programming through June 30, 2023.

Background:

Senate Bill 1 (SB 1) (Beall, Chapter 5, Statutes of 2017) created the Local Partnership Program. Assembly Bill 115 (Committee on Budget, Chapter 20, Statutes of 2017) clarified SB 1 language regarding local and regional transportation agency eligibility and expanded the types of projects eligible for the program. SB 1 authorizes \$200 million annually to fund the Local Partnership Program. The Local Partnership Formulaic Program provides funding to counties, cities, districts, and regional transportation agencies in which voters have approved fees or taxes dedicated solely to transportation improvements. Only agencies with Commission-adopted funding and committed local matching funds are eligible to receive the Local Partnership Formulaic Program funding.

Resolution LPP-P-2223-06

Be It Resolved, that the Commission does hereby amend the Local Partnership Formulaic Program to:

- 1. Delete the Richmond Street Curb, Signing, Marking Improvements Project in Contra Costa County and make the funding available to reprogram and allocate until June 30, 2023.
- 2. Add the Oakland Alameda Access Project in Alameda County and program \$196,000 to the Right-of-Way phase in fiscal year 2022-23.
- 3. Add the Ingomar Grade Rehabilitation Project in Merced County and program \$786,000 to the Construction phase in fiscal year 2022-23.
- 4. Add the Lincoln Boulevard Rehabilitation Project in Merced County and program \$800,000 to the Construction phase in fiscal year 2022-23.
- 5. Add the El Cerrito del Norte Transit-Oriented Development Complete Streets Improvements Project in Contra Costa County and program \$400,000 to the Construction phase in fiscal year 2022-23.
- 6. Amend the State Route 132 Phase 2: Four-lane Expressway from Dakota Avenue to Needham Street Project in Stanislaus County and program \$3,217,000 to the Right-of-Way phase in fiscal year 2022-23.
- 7. Amend the Truckee Railyard Transit Center Phase 1 Project in Nevada County and deprogram \$400,000 from the Right-of-Way phase.
- 8. Amend the Truckee Railyard Transit Center Phase 1 Project in Nevada County and program \$400,000 to the Construction phase in fiscal year 2022-23.
