ISSUE:

Should the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve an allocation of \$2,500,000 for the locally-administered State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) Transit B-Line Zero Emission Bus Rollout Transit project (PPNO 3203), in Butte County?

RECOMMENDATION:

The California Department of Transportation recommends that the Commission approve an allocation of \$2,500,000 for the locally-administered STIP Transit B-Line Zero Emission Bus Rollout Transit project (PPNO 3203), in Butte County.

BACKGROUND:
