Subject: <u>SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDS ALLOCATION FOR A TRANSIT AND INTERCITY RAIL</u> <u>CAPITAL PROGRAM – (2018:17) BLUE LINE RAIL CORRIDOR TRANSIT</u> <u>ENHANCEMENTS (BLUE LINE FEEDER BUS SERVICE (11 BUSES)</u> <u>FOR ROUTE 925) (PPNO CP032)</u> <u>RESOLUTION TIRCP-2223-905</u>

ISSUE:

Should the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve a request for an additional \$66,000 for the Construction (CON) phase of the Transit and Intercity Rail Capital Program (TIRCP) (2018:17) Blue Line Rail Corridor Transit Enhancements (Blue Line Feeder Bus Service (11 Buses) for Route 925) component (PPNO CP032), in San Diego County?

RECOMMENDATION:

The California Department of Transportation recommends that the Commission approve a request for an additional \$66,000 for the CON phase of the TIRCP (2018:17) Blue Line Rail Corridor Transit Enhancements (Blue Line Feeder Bus Service (11 Buses) for Route 925) component (PPNO CP032), in San Diego County.

BACKGROUND:

In June 2021, under Resolution TIRCP-2021-30, the Commission approved an allocation of \$13,316,000 for the CON phase of the (2018:17) Blue Line Rail Corridor Transit Enhancements (Blue Line Feeder Bus Service (11 Buses) for Route 925) component.

PROJECT LOCATION AND DESCRIPTION:

The (2018:17) Blue Line Rail Corridor Transit Enhancements (Blue Line Feeder Bus Service (11 Buses) for Route 925) component, located in San Diego County, will result in the procurement of 11 battery-electric buses to service the new Iris Rapid Route 925.

FUNDING STATUS:

This project component was originally programmed for \$13,316,000 for the CON phase. However, an additional \$66,000 is needed to complete the phase. These supplemental funds for CON will be redirected from project savings of funding originally programmed and allocated to the Network Integration component CON phase.

REASON(S) FOR THE COST INCREASE:

San Diego Metropolitan Transportation System is requesting this supplemental funding to cover the project cost increase due to the project budget being underestimated at the time of application, and supply chain issues driving up the costs in obtaining the necessary components to build the buses. With the approval of these supplemental funds, the CON phase is expected to be completed by June 2024.

CONSEQUENCES:

Without this supplemental allocation of \$66,000, the (2018:17) Blue Line Rail Corridor Transit Enhancements (Blue Line Feeder Bus Service (11 Buses) for Route 925) component delivery of the 11 battery-electric buses will be delayed until additional funding is secured to complete the CON phase.

FINANCIAL RESOLUTION:

Be it Resolved, that an additional \$66,000 be allocated from the Budget Act of 2021, Item 2660-101-0046 for the TIRCP (2018:17) Blue Line Rail Corridor Transit Enhancements (Blue Line Feeder Bus Service (11 Buses) for Route 925) component (PPNO CP032).
