### **ISSUE:**

Should the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve an allocation of \$29,000,000 for the locally-administered Senate Bill 1 (SB 1) Trade Corridor Enhancement Program (TCEP) Turnbull Canyon Road Grade Separation Rail Project (PPNO T0009), in Los Angeles County?

### **RECOMMENDATION:**

The California Department of Transportation recommends that the Commission approve an allocation of \$29,000,000 for the locally-administered SB 1 TCEP Turnbull Canyon Road Grade Separation Rail Project (PPNO T0009), in Los Angeles County.

### **BACKGROUND:**

The attached vote list describes the locally-administered SB 1 TCEP Rail project totaling \$29,000,000. The local agency is ready to proceed with this project, and is requesting an allocation at this time.
