Subject: ALLOCATION AMENDMENT FOR TRANSIT AND INTERCITY RAIL CAPITAL PROGRAM PROJECTS

ISSUE:

Should the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve an allocation amendment for the Transit and Intercity Rail Capital Program (TIRCP) (2018:17) Blue Line Rail Corridor Transit Enhancements project, in San Diego County, to deallocate a combined total of \$383,000 from three components to reflect component savings?

RECOMMENDATION:

The California Department of Transportation recommends that the Commission approve an allocation amendment for the TIRCP (2018:17) Blue Line Rail Corridor Transit Enhancements project, in San Diego County, to deallocate a combined total of \$383,000 from three components as described in the table below, to reflect component savings.

BACKGROUND:

The (2018:17) Blue Line Rail Corridor Transit Enhancements components listed have been completed with component savings in the respective phase. The San Diego Metropolitan Transportation System is requesting that the savings of \$317,000 be deallocated and used for the construction (CON) phase of the Beech Street Double Crossover component, and the savings of \$66,000 be deallocated and used for the CON phase of the Blue Line Feeder Bus Service (11 Buses) for Route 925 component. The proposed changes are reflected in the strikethrough and bold in the attached vote boxes.
