AMENDMENT

RESOLUTION G-23-59, AMENDING RESOLUTION G-22-38

ISSUE:

Should the California Transportation Commission (Commission) amend the California Department of Transportation's (Department) Division of Transportation Planning Aeronautics Program (Aeronautics) 2022 Acquisition and Development (A&D) Program?

RECOMMENDATION:

The Department recommends the Commission amend the Aeronautics 2022 A&D Program as listed on the attached documents.

BACKGROUND:

The projects proposed in the Aeronautics 2022 A&D Program are A&D projects. They are State-funded at 90 percent of the total project, with a 10 percent local match required.

The Aeronautics 2022 A&D Program was adopted at the Commission's June 2022 meeting, and includes 21 projects totaling \$3 million and covers two fiscal years: 2022–23 and 2023–24. These projects were selected from the 2021 Capital Improvement Plan (CIP).

At the June 2023 Commission meeting, the current 2023 CIP was adopted. The Aeronautics 2022 A&D Program is being amended to align with the most recently adopted CIP and remove any 2022-23 projects that remain unallocated. Any projects programmed for 2022-23 that have been included in the 2023 CIP have been moved to 2023-24 to be funded, should funds become available. The projects that have not been submitted in the most recent CIP are being deprogrammed via this action item.
