Subject: Adoption of the Fiscal Year 2023-24 Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account, Local Streets and Roads Funding Initial Report of Eligible Cities and Counties Resolution G-23-61.

Recommendation:

Staff recommends the California Transportation Commission (Commission) adopt the Fiscal Year 2023-24 Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account, Local Streets and Roads Funding Initial Report of Eligible Cities and Counties as provided in Attachment B, and direct staff to transmit the list of eligible jurisdictions to the State Controller (Controller).

<u>lssue:</u>

Under Senate Bill 1 (Beall, Chapter 5, Statutes of 2017), a percentage of Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account funding is apportioned by formula and disbursed monthly by the Controller's Office to eligible cities and counties for basic road maintenance, rehabilitation, and critical safety projects on the local streets and roads system. Senate Bill 1 requires the Commission to determine eligibility for the funds and report this information to the Controller each year.

For Fiscal Year 2023-24, the Commission must submit the adopted Initial Report of Eligible Cities and Counties to the Controller on or by August 31, 2023. Eligible cities and counties will begin receiving monthly disbursements from the Controller in September 2023. Cities and counties are estimated to receive approximately \$1.4 billion for Fiscal Year 2023-24.

For jurisdictions to be included in the Fiscal Year 2023-24 initial eligibility report, jurisdictions had to adopt, by resolution, a list of projects and send this list to the Commission no later than July 1, 2023. Senate Bill 1 and the 2021 Local Streets and Road Funding Program Guidelines require each project on a city or county's list to include a project's description, location detail, useful life, and schedule.

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By July 1, 2023, 526 out of 539 California jurisdictions submitted the required resolution and project list detail to the Commission. The 526 jurisdictions (469 cities and 57 counties) deemed eligible for funding are identified in the Initial Report of Eligible Cities and Counties (Attachment B).

Commission staff have confirmed that all other remaining cities intend to seek subsequent funding eligibility by September 2023. For a period of 90 days, the Controller will retain apportionment amounts for the remaining cities (12) and single county. Commission staff will continue to work with these jurisdictions to ensure timely and complete submittals for subsequent eligibility. These jurisdictions also are identified in the Initial Report of Eligible Cities and Counties (Attachment B).

Complete submittals received after the initial July 1, 2023 deadline, but on or before September 30, 2023, will be brought forward for adoption at the October 2023 Commission meeting, as allowable by program guidelines.

Any submittals received after September 30, 2023 will not be included in the subsequent eligibility list for Fiscal Year 2023-24, and therefore those jurisdictions would not receive monthly disbursements for the fiscal year. The Controller would recalculate and disburse those funds forfeited by existing formula, amongst jurisdictions that have been deemed eligible for Fiscal Year 2023-24 funding.

RESOLUTION G-23-61

- 1.1 **WHEREAS**, on April 28, 2017, Governor Brown signed Senate Bill (SB) 1 (Beall, Chapter 5, Statutes of 2017), known as the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017 to address basic road maintenance, rehabilitation, and critical safety needs on both the state highway and local streets and road system; and
- 1.2 WHEREAS, beginning November 1, 2017, portions of new funding from increases to certain fuel excise taxes and vehicle fees were deposited into the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account, and a percentage of this new funding is apportioned monthly by formula by the State Controller pursuant to paragraph (2) of subdivision (h) of Section 2032 of the Streets and Highways Code to eligible cities and counties for basic road maintenance, rehabilitation, and critical safety projects on local streets and roads; and
- 1.3 WHEREAS, Streets and Highways Code Section 2034(a)(1) requires that prior to receiving an apportionment of Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account funds pursuant to paragraph (2) of subdivision (h) of Section 2032 from the Controller in a fiscal year, an eligible city or county shall submit to the California Transportation Commission (Commission) a list of projects proposed to be funded with these funds pursuant to an adopted resolution; and
- 1.4 WHEREAS, Streets and Highways Code Section 2034(a)(2) requires that the Commission report to the State Controller the cities and counties that have submitted a list of projects as described in this subdivision and that are therefore eligible to receive an apportionment of funds under the program for the applicable fiscal year. The State Controller, upon receipt of the report, shall apportion funds to eligible cities and counties; and
- 1.5 **WHEREAS**, Streets and Highways Code Section 2034(a)(1) specifies that the project list shall not limit the flexibility of an eligible city or county to fund projects in accordance with local needs and priorities, so long as the projects are consistent with Streets and Highways Code Section 2030(b); and

- 1.6 WHEREAS, the Commission, in consultation with cities, counties, and their representatives as well as the State Controller's Office and other stakeholders, developed the 2021 Local Streets and Roads Funding Program Annual Reporting Guidelines adopted by the Commission on March 24, 2021, revising the detail and process for the project list submittal and project expenditure reporting; and
- 1.7 **WHEREAS**, Commission staff collected the Fiscal Year 2023-24 project list resolution submittals from cities and counties as required by Streets and Highways Code Section 2034(a)(1); and
- 1.8 **WHEREAS**, While Commission staff (pursuant to Streets and Highways Code Section 2034(a)(1)) reviewed submittals for completeness, Commission staff did not select or authorize the projects listed; and
- 1.9 WHEREAS, Commission staff compiled a list of cities and counties that provided complete project list resolution submittals and those jurisdictions are therefore eligible to receive Fiscal Year 2023-24 formula apportionments of Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account, Local Streets and Roads Funding, as reflected in the attached Initial Report of Eligible Cities and Counties; and
- 1.10 WHEREAS, that attachment is intended to serve as the initial report of eligible cities and counties as required by Streets and Highways Code Section 2034(a)(2), for transmittal to the State Controller.
- 2.1 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** that the Commission adopts the Fiscal Year 2023-24 Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account, Local Streets and Roads Funding Initial Report of Eligible Cities and Counties; and
- 2.2 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that Commission staff is authorized to make minor technical changes as needed to the report; and
- 2.3 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Commission directs staff to transmit the report to the State Controller as required by Streets and Highways Code Section 2034(a)(2).
