Port of Long Beach Pier G & J Double Track

Approximately 8,000 feet of a second rail line allows a full unit train to land at Pier J without blocking at-grade crossings or adjacent terminals.


- Reduces VMT

- Improves congestion






Solano I-80/I-680/SR12 Interchange Package 2A
