

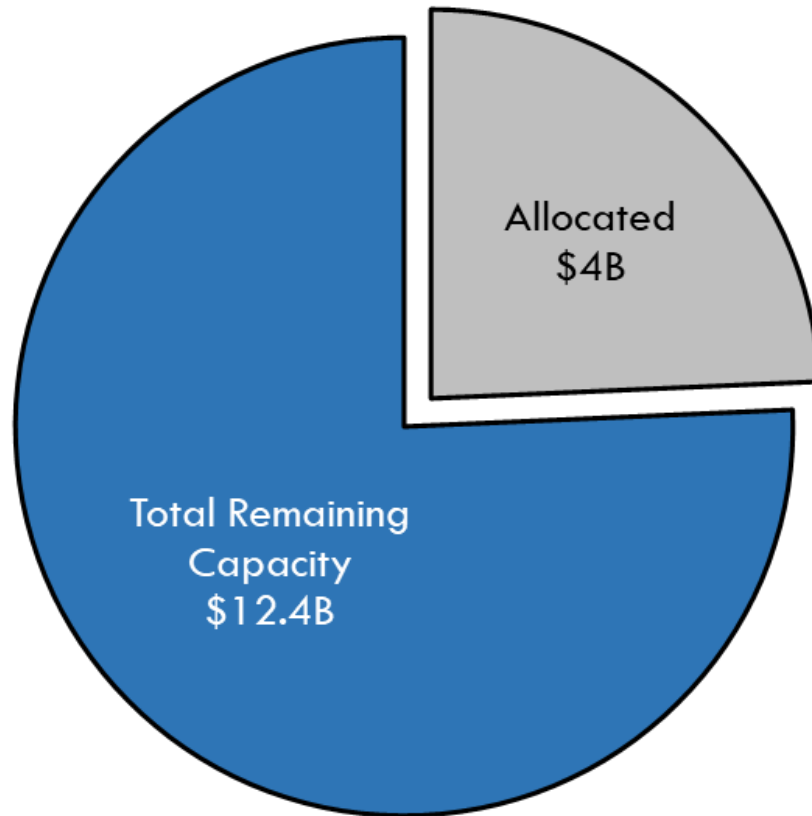


Budget and Allocation Capacity Update

G-12 Progress Report through September 2023

- G-12's represent delegated authority to make adjustments (increases or decreases) to project funding.
- Through September 2023, Caltrans has processed the following changes:
 - SHOPP: Approximately \$22 million in increases from 31 projects, and \$30 million in savings from 36 projects.
 - STIP: Program savings of \$199,000 from one project
