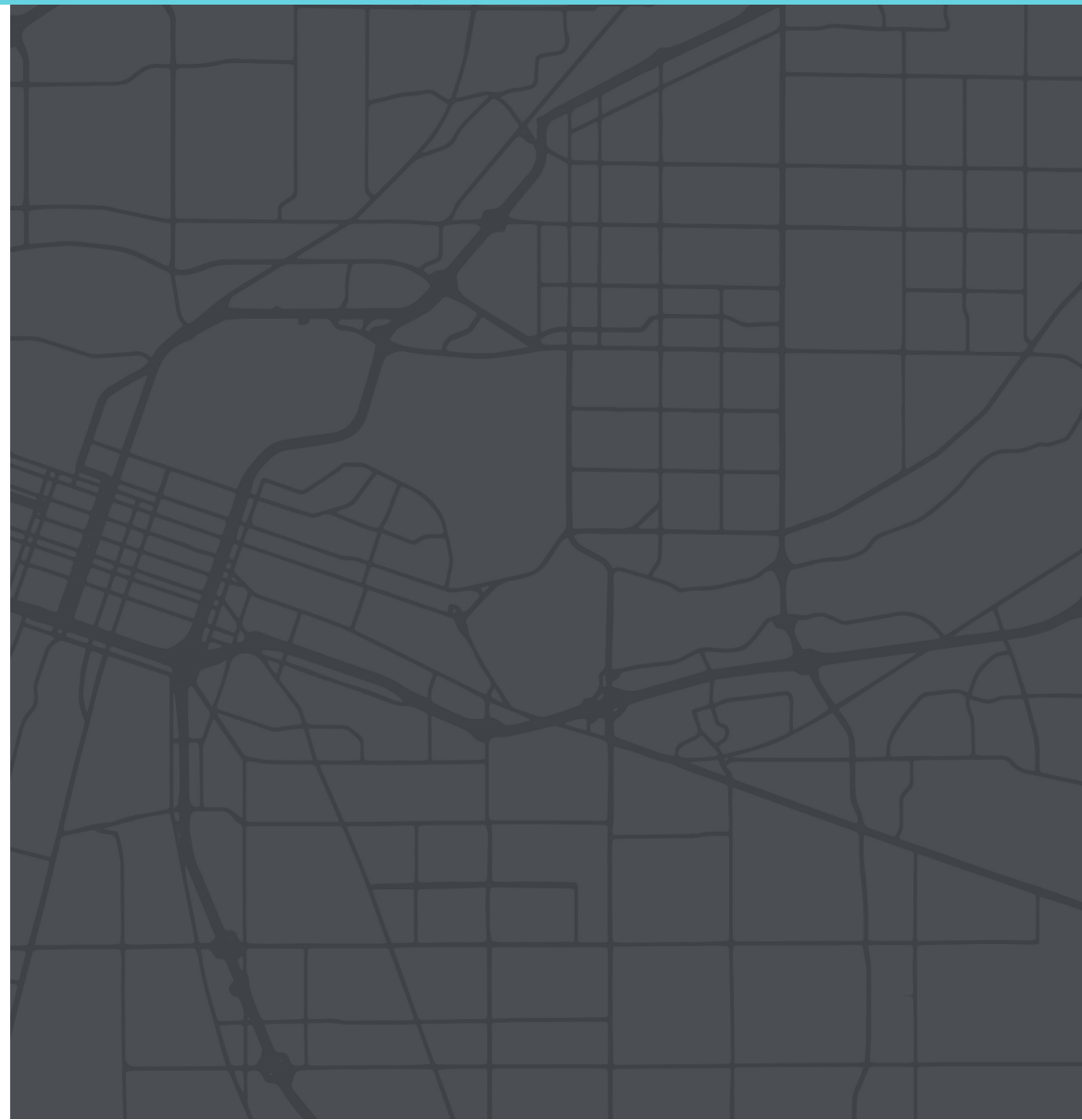

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# CSIS Overview

- **Why Develop the Caltrans System Investment Strategy (CSIS)?**
  - Implement the California Action Plan for Transportation Infrastructure (CAPTI) Key Action S4.1
  - Align Caltrans project nominations with the CAPTI through a data- and performance-driven approach
- **What is the CSIS?**
  - Caltrans investment framework to prioritize projects that advance State goals & policies
  - Methodology & process to assess alignment with CAPTI for state & federal funding programs
  - Greater transparency and collaboration in the decision-making process
- **What CSIS Does NOT Do**
  - Does not prevent local and regional partners from applying to SB1 programs projects
  - Does not affect SHOPP
