FTA 5310 Program Overview

Program Goal: Improve mobility for seniors and individuals with disabilities by removing barriers to transportation services and expanding the transportation mobility options

Project Types: ADA accessible vehicles, equipment, operating assistance and mobility management projects

Eligible Applicants: Private non-profit agencies and qualifying public agencies

Partnership and Engagement: Coordinated Public Transit Human Services Transportation Plan and multiple application workshops

FTA 5310 Program Funding

FFY 2015-2017 Cycle: \$41.7 million to 120 Agencies for 281 ADA vehicles, 13 equipment awards, 94 operating and mobility management projects

FFY 2018-2019 Cycle: \$33.3 million to 124 agencies for 218 ADA vehicles, 20 equipment awards, 79 operating and mobility management projects

FFY 2020-2021 Cycle: \$35.2 million to 109 agencies, 165 ADA vehicles, 15 equipment awards, 81 operating and mobility management projects
