**RESOLUTION FP-23-64** 

### <u>ISSUE:</u>

Should the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve an allocation of \$248,551,000 for 18 projects programmed in the State Highway Operation and Protection Program (SHOPP)?

## **RECOMMENDATION:**

The California Department of Transportation (Department) recommends that the Commission approve an allocation of \$248,551,000 for 18 SHOPP projects.

#### **BACKGROUND:**

The attached vote list describes 18 SHOPP projects totaling \$248,551,000. The Department is ready to proceed with these projects, and is requesting an allocation at this time.

#### **FINANCIAL RESOLUTION:**

Resolved that \$220,196,000 be allocated from the Budget Acts of 2022 and 2023, Budget Act Items 2660-302-0042, 2660-302-0890, and 2660-302-3290, and Non-Budget Act Item 2660-802-3290 for construction and \$28,355,000 for construction engineering for 18 SHOPP projects described on the attached vote list.
