**Subject**: Local Partnership Formulaic Program Amendment, Resolution LPP-P-2324-09, Amending Resolution LPP-P-2324-06

## **Recommendation:**

Staff recommends the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve an amendment to the Local Partnership Formulaic Program with the following actions:

- Add the Hillcrest Road Improvement Project in San Francisco County and program \$2,600,000 to the Construction phase in fiscal year 2023-24.
- Amend the US 101 Multimodal Corridor High Occupancy Vehicle Segment 4E South project in Santa Barbara County and program an additional \$158,000 to the Construction phase in fiscal year 2023-24 for a total programmed amount of \$2,742,000.
- Amend the Bay Skyway Phase 1 Yerba Buena Island Multi-Use Path project in San Francisco County and program \$1,000 to the Plans, Specifications, & Estimates phase in fiscal year 2023-24.

### <u>lssue:</u>

Commission staff reviewed each request to amend the Local Partnership Formulaic Program. The amendment requests are summarized below:

 As the taxing and implementing agency, the San Francisco County Transportation Authority requests to add the Hillcrest Road Improvement Project in San Francisco County and program \$2,600,000 of its available 2022 Formulaic Program funding to the Construction phase in fiscal year 2023-24. This project will upgrade the roadway to modern standards and accommodate a future Class I multi-use path and Class II bike lane by widening the roadway to include 8-foot shoulders and reconstruction of existing retaining walls. The widened roadway will not add a new traffic lane. Anticipated benefits of this project include improved vehicular and bicycle safety, improved access to the San Francisco-Oakland Bay Bridge, and improved bicycle and pedestrian access to and from downtown San Francisco.

# **CALIFORNIA TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION**

- At the October 2023 Commission meeting, the Commission deallocated project cost savings of \$158,000 from two projects in Santa Barbara County. The savings are available to the Santa Barbara County Association of Governments for reprogramming and allocation until October 31, 2024. The Santa Barbara County Association of Governments requests to amend the US 101 Multimodal Corridor project in Santa Barbara County to add \$158,000 for a total programmed amount of \$2,742,000. The funds will be programmed to the Construction phase in fiscal year 2023-24. The total project cost remains unchanged. This project will reduce congestion and delays, improve travel time, provide for High Occupancy Vehicle Lane continuity in southern Santa Barbara County, and is a critical north-south connector when alternative parallel routes, like Interstate 5, are closed for emergencies. Anticipated project benefits include critical safety benefits, improved truck traffic flow, and reduced emissions for the corridor which serves as: a Strategic Interregional Corridor, a critical commuter route, an evacuation route, and is designated by the Federal Highway Administration as a Critical Urban Freight Corridor.
- As the taxing and implementing agency, the San Francisco County Transportation Authority requests to program \$1,000 of available 2022 Formulaic Program funding to the Plans, Specifications, & Estimates phase of the Bay Skyway Phase 1 – Yerba Buena Island Multi-Use Path project in fiscal year 2023-24. This project will construct 1.2 miles of bicycle and pedestrian facilities. Anticipated project benefits include improved bicycle and pedestrian commuter and recreational access between the East Bay and downtown San Francisco.

Commission staff have reviewed these requests and found them to be consistent with the 2022 Local Partnership Formulaic Program Guidelines.

The Local Partnership Formulaic Program has programmed 228 projects totaling \$806 million since 2018. This action leaves \$99 million of the 2022 Local Partnership Formulaic Program funding available for programming through June 30, 2026.

# Background:

Senate Bill 1 (Beall, Chapter 5, Statutes of 2017) created the Local Partnership Program. Assembly Bill 115 (Committee on Budget, Chapter 20, Statutes of 2017) clarified Senate Bill 1 language regarding local and regional transportation agency eligibility and expanded the types of projects eligible for the program. Senate Bill 1 authorizes \$200 million annually to fund the Local Partnership Program.

The Local Partnership Formulaic Program provides funding to counties, cities, districts, and regional transportation agencies in which voters have approved fees, taxes, or tolls dedicated solely to transportation improvements. Only agencies included in the Commission-adopted Local Partnership Formulaic Program Funding Distribution are eligible to request funding for projects in the Local Partnership Formulaic Program.
