Subject: ALLOCATION FOR LOCALLY-ADMINISTERED SENATE BILL 1 TRADE CORRIDOR ENHANCEMENT PROGRAM PROJECTS ON THE STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM RESOLUTION TCEP-A-2324-13

ISSUE:

Should the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve an allocation of \$12,000,000 for two locally-administered Senate Bill 1 (SB 1) Trade Corridor Enhancement Program (TCEP) projects, on the State Highway System?

RECOMMENDATION:

The California Department of Transportation recommends that the Commission approve an allocation of \$12,000,000 for two locally-administered SB 1 TCEP projects, on the State Highway System.

BACKGROUND:

The attached vote list describes two locally-administered SB 1 TCEP projects totaling \$12,000,000. The local agencies are ready to proceed with these projects, and are requesting an allocation at this time.

FINANCIAL RESOLUTION:

Resolved that \$12,000,000 be allocated from the Budget Act of 2021, Budget Act Item 2660-301-3291 for two locally-administered SB 1 TCEP projects described on the attached vote list.
