**Subject**: Adoption of the Small Urban and Rural Areas 2023 Program of Projects for the Federal Transit Administration Section 5310 Enhanced Mobility of Seniors and

Individuals with Disabilities Program

### **Recommendation:**

Staff recommends the California Transportation Commission (Commission) adopt the Small Urban and Rural Areas 2023 Program of Projects for the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Section 5310 Enhanced Mobility of Seniors and Individuals with Disabilities Program (Section 5310 Program) as proposed in Attachment B.

## Issue:

The funding available for the 2023 Section 5310 Program is \$22,377,731. The 2023 Section 5310 Program proposes to program 123 projects as follows:

- \$11,729,042 to 79 projects for the Traditional Small Urban Program
- \$3,726,663 to 23 projects for the Traditional Rural Program
- •\$4,211,726 to 10 projects for the Expanded Small Urban Program
- \$2,710,300 to 11 projects for the Expanded Rural Program

The 2023 Section 5310 Program also includes contingency lists should funding become available due to savings or project cancelation. The contingency lists include \$4,301,000 to 32 Traditional Small Urban projects; \$1,233,428 to four Expanded Small Urban projects; and \$1,804,173 to six Expanded Rural projects.

# **Background:**

Pursuant to Government Code Section 14055 et seq., the Commission is responsible for approving the Small Urban and Rural Areas Program of Projects for Section 5310 Program. The Commission must also establish an appeals process and hold at least one public hearing prior to allocating funds.

The Draft Small Urban and Rural Areas 2023 Program of Projects for the Section 5310 Program was presented to the Commission at the January Commission meeting. On February 7, 2024 the required appeals hearing was held with no appeals heard.

# ADOPTION OF THE 2023 SMALL URBAN AND RURAL AREA FEDERAL TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION SECTION 5310 ENHANCED MOBILITY OF SENIORS AND INDIVIDUALS WITH DISABILITIES PROGRAM

#### Resolution No. G-24-39

- 1.1 WHEREAS, Federal law (Title 49 U.S.C. Section 5310) provides for capital, operating assistance, and mobility management grants for the purpose of assisting private non-profit corporations and under certain circumstances, public agencies in providing transportation services to meet the needs of elderly persons and persons with disabilities for whom public mass transportation services are otherwise unavailable, insufficient, or inappropriate, and
- 1.2 WHEREAS, State law, Assembly Bill 772 (Chapter 669, Statutes of 1996), placed the following three mandates on the California Transportation Commission (Commission) regarding the Program: a) The Commission shall direct the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) on how to allocate funds for the Program; b) The Commission shall establish an appeals process for the Program; c) The Commission shall hold at least one public hearing prior to approving its Program of Projects, and
- 1.3 WHEREAS, the Commission worked with a State Review Committee, a 15-member advisory committee made up of individuals from the Regional Transportation Agencies, state and local social service agencies, the California Association for Coordinated Transportation, Caltrans, and Commission staff, to develop a process that provides for a statewide ranked list of Small Urban and Rural Area projects to be adopted by the Commission and funded by Caltrans, and
- 1.4 **WHEREAS,** the available funding totals \$22,377,731. This amount is distributed as follows: Traditional (55 percent) and Expanded Projects (45 percent), and
- 1.5 **WHEREAS,** 102 projects for a total of \$15,455,705 for the Traditional program and 21 projects for a total of \$6,922,026 for the Expanded program were selected for funding, and
- 1.6 **WHEREAS,** if projects are not delivered from the funded list or savings are generated, projects below the line will be selected for funding, and
- 1.7 **WHEREAS,** Caltrans and Commission staff held the required appeals hearing on February 7, 2024, and
- 1.8 **WHEREAS**, the appeals hearing did not result in changes to the Small Urban and Rural Area Statewide Prioritized List, and

- 1.9 **WHEREAS**, the Commission held the required public hearing prior to adoption.
- 2.1 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** that the Commission hereby adopts the attached list of projects, as the 2023 Small Urban and Rural Area Federal Transit Administration Section 5310 Enhanced Mobility of Seniors and Individuals with Disabilities Program, and
- 2.2 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** that in adopting the attached list, the Commission hereby directs Caltrans to allocate funds for projects on that list down to the level of actual available funding, pursuant to California Government Code Section 14055.2(b).
