ISSUE:

Should the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve an allocation of \$23,277,000 for the locally-administered multi-funded Senate Bill 1 (SB 1) Local Partnership Program (LPP) (Competitive)/State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) South Watt Avenue Improvements - Florin Road to Jackson Road project (PPNO 1807), off the State Highway System, in Sacramento County?

RECOMMENDATION:

The California Department of Transportation recommends that the Commission approve an allocation of \$23,277,000 for the locally-administered multi-funded SB 1 LPP (Competitive)/STIP South Watt Avenue Improvements - Florin Road to Jackson Road project (PPNO 1807), off the State Highway System, in Sacramento County.

BACKGROUND:

The attached vote list describes the locally-administered multi-funded SB 1 LPP (Competitive)/STIP project totaling \$23,277,000. The local agency is ready to proceed with this project, and is requesting an allocation at this time.
