Subject: ALLOCATION FOR A LOCALLY-ADMINISTERED MULTI-FUNDED SENATE
BILL 1 TRADE CORRIDOR ENHANCEMENT PROGRAM/STATE
TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM PROJECT ON THE STATE
HIGHWAY SYSTEM (ADVANCEMENT FISCAL YEAR 2024-25)

ISSUE:

Should the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve an allocation of \$6,300,000 for the locally-administered multi-funded Senate Bill 1 (SB 1) Trade Corridor Enhancement Program (TCEP)/State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) Centennial Corridor SB99 to WB58 Connector project (PPNO 8030), on the State Highway System, in Kern County, programmed in Fiscal Year 2024-25?

RECOMMENDATION:

The California Department of Transportation recommends that the Commission approve an allocation of \$6,300,000 for the locally-administered multi-funded SB 1 TCEP/STIP Centennial Corridor SB99 to WB58 Connector project (PPNO 8030), on the State Highway System, in Kern County, programmed in 2024-25.

BACKGROUND:

The attached vote list describes the locally-administered multi-funded SB 1 TCEP/STIP project totaling \$6,300,000. The local agency is ready to proceed with this project, and is requesting an allocation at this time.
